As you're out shopping for holiday gifts and finding great deals for yourself, keep in mind that your HIFICU Visa and Debit cards have daily transaction and dollar limits in place for your protection against fraud. These limits are designed to prevent large, unexpected charges from being made to your account. To avoid any surprises, it's a good idea to be aware of these limits so you're not caught off guard if your card is declined, even though you have available funds.



- HIFICU Visa Card: 15 transactions per day, up to your credit limit
- HIFICU Debit Card: 15 transactions per day, up to \$5,000 total per day

Inspect Cash for Counterfeits

During the holiday season, you might handle more cash than usual. Take a moment to check the authenticity of the cash you're handling, especially at pop-ups and fairs.

How to Spot Counterfeit Cash:

- •Look for watermarks.
- •Feel the texture.
- •Use a counterfeit detection pen.

Be Cautious About Using Your Card at Unfamiliar Stores

While the majority of businesses are trustworthy, there are also scammers that set up fake storefronts or fraudulent online stores designed to steal your card or personal information.

- •Use secure payment methods such as Apple Pay or Google Pay.
- •Avoid using public Wi-Fi: When making online purchases, always use a secure, private Wi-Fi connection.
- •Do your research: Before making a purchase, check for reviews or customer feedback on the website or store.



Watch Out for Holiday Charity Scams

Before donating, it's important to verify that the organization you're giving to is reputable and trustworthy.

How to Avoid Charity Scams:

- •Research before you donate: Use sites like Charity Navigator, Guidestar, or BBB Wise Giving Alliance to verify the charity.
- •Avoid unsolicited donation requests: If someone calls or emails you out of the blue asking for a donation, it could be a scam.
- •Donate through official channels: Only give money or goods through a charity's official website, local event, or trusted partner.


Watch Your Spending



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
Download the HIFICU MyCard APP on the Apple or Google Play store.
